

Pool and Backyard FAQ's

July 30, 2018

- When will the Pool / Back Yard project start?
 - Construction is scheduled to begin in the fall of 2018 with a targeted completion date of early May 2019 for the Pool
- What amenities are available at the Pool
 - Outdoor Bar
 - o Multiple dining seating areas both open air and enclosed
 - o Cabana's
 - Outdoor built in Grille
 - o 15,000 square foot furnished deck
 - o 5,000 square foot pool
 - o Flat Screen TV's
 - Additional F&B Venue for Golfers
 - Trellis area for Outside Entertainment to perform during Special Member Events
- Are all Memberships eligible to go to the Pool
 - All Golf Members and Sport Members can enjoy the Pool facilities.
 - Guest Fees will be established and posted at a later date
- What Amenities will be on the Range
 - o The Range will Feature 2 Hitting Bays for Teaching
 - The Range will expand in Size
- Why was the Chipping Green relocated?
 - The Members Patio area was developed to capture both views of the City and the Mountains for Member Social Events
 - The Short Game Practice area allows for a more private area for chipping

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- What additional amenities will be featured in the Back Yard
 - Redesigned putting green to include low level lighting for evening time putting
 - O Water feature viewable from the front entrance of the club
 - Bocce Courts
 - o Member Event Lawn Area for Bounce Houses
 - Additional Private Cart parking
- Additional Items
 - Golf Cart traffic flow will be reconfigured to relieve the congestion around the back of the clubhouse
 - Dedicated private cart parking will be developed to allow access to the clubhouse
 - Tournament staging for golf carts will be more adjacent to the range rather than the golf shop
- What if anything is being done on the Golf Course?
 - March 2018, Aggressive improvements in golf course and maintenance routine, "Green's, Tee's, and Turf"
 - o April 2018, New Yamaha Quiet Tech Golf Cart Fleet
 - Spring 2018, New Spreader, Virticuter, Mowers, and Aeration equipment
 - o Irrigations upgrades, \$1.4 Million Over the Next Two Years
 - Bunker Renovation, Design, Drainage, and Higher Quality of Sand
 - Cart Path Repairs and Additions
 - o Increase Golf Course Maintenance Staff by 30%
