Course Update

Happy New Year, everyone!

With the mild winter and excellent playing conditions, the amount of cart traffic is doing significant damage to our frozen turf without any chance of recovery until spring. Even though the grass is for the most part dormant, it still needs moisture to survive, and so far we're not getting much precipitation. We are seriously close to going 'Carts on paths only'. We don't want to that, and are monitoring the conditions daily. Part of our plan is alternating weekly course closures, and we think this will help relieve the pressure to our turf. Also, we are going to path only on the short par 4's, since there just isn't enough entry and exit positions to use with the limited space available. The more compact the space, the more concentrated the cart traffic. So the holes we're referring to, besides all par 3's, are #17 and #18 Legend and #5 Challenge. We've done this before, so it isn't anything new. For you members who have been around awhile, you know the serious consequences of a dry winter, coupled with much daily play and then coming into spring with a whole lot of dead turf. Nobody wants to see that again, ever. Also, when we do have some snow cover, and we're allowing carts, please drive around the snow, or it could leave damage. I don't know about you, but we're all hoping for some snow, or at least a little rain. Thanks for being a member!



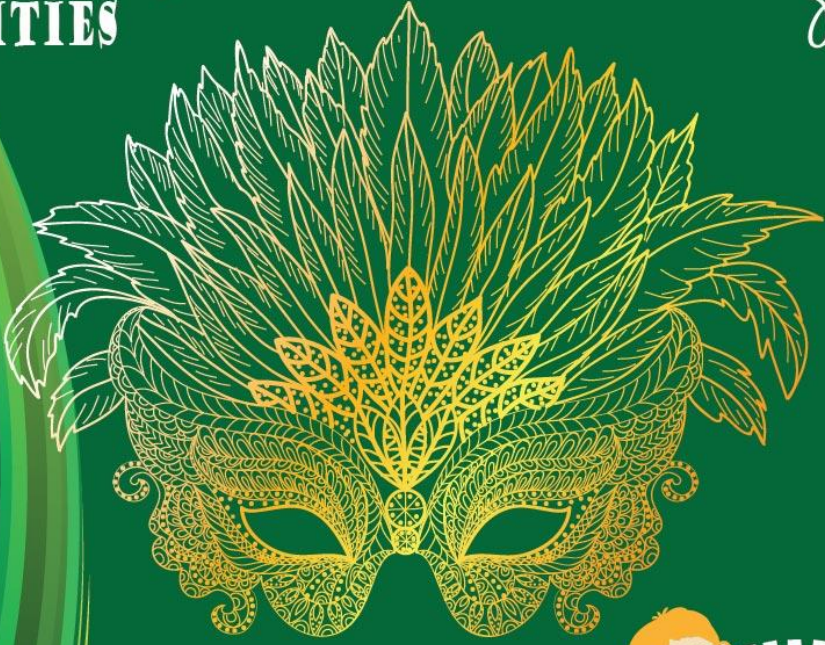

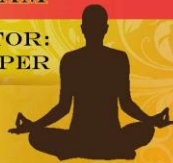
