Member support spearheaded the success of the Adopt a Hole Sprinkler Program and the Biggest Little Cup golf tournament. These two programs combined raised over \$120,000. These funds have been used to upgrade the sprinkler heads on the golf course and purchase new furniture for Redfield's Grill. Improvements continued with the replacement of one the \$35,000 main irrigation pumps. This pump brings our water pressure to full capacity. The new pump and sprinkler heads we will provide us with improved playing conditions for the remainder of this year and for seasons to come.

This fall season introduces the commencement of the following projects to continue to enhance your Member experience at your club:

- Additional sprinkler head leveling and raising.
- Installing hole name plaques
- Wall to wall gypsum application which will help condition our soil and result in better playing conditions.
- Repainting of the exterior of the clubhouse
- Removing and improving the flooring in the outdoor hitting bays for practice during the winter.
- Replacing some of the most damaged cart paths.

Our Club has been recognized as a great private club by so many in the market because of the friendly and fun environment our Members create. We will continue to provide our

Members a full calendar of events to enjoy with fellow members and also to invite good friends to share the fun of your Club. We will close out 2017 with our Thank You for being a Member Mixer, Halloween Carnival, and Breakfast with Santa, Christmas Brunch and the New Year's Eve Extravaganza. And of course, you can enjoy dining during our normal grille hours. Our members have also embraced starting various Clubs within a Club. 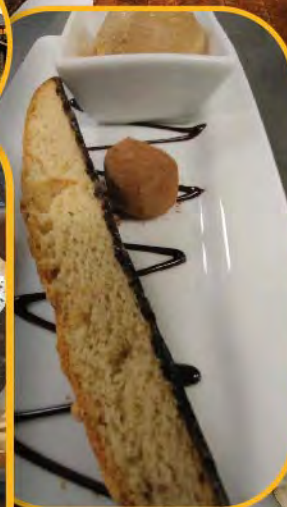
CHIEF'S

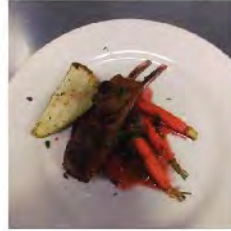

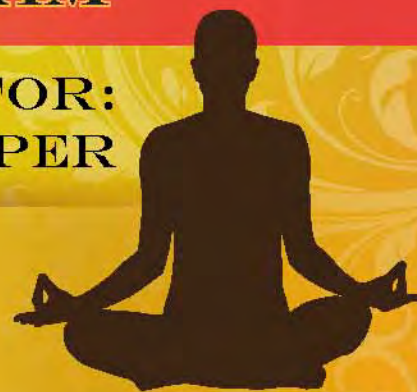
