# Tuff

RS I sit here watching blizzard conditions out my window on March 28th, I truly am grateful for the moisture it's bringing to the courses. But it does slow us up for a few days while it melts.

It's all going good with aeration and we're on schedule with that. Our new core pulverizer in our fairway aeration process is working out beautifully, saving us loads of time, and giving us the benefit of returning the soil from the plugs back to the turf. We have experienced our typical set backs with spring start-up of the irrigation system, although we are far ahead of the game over previous years. We were able to get some cart path repair work done in March and will continue that program in early April.

#### SPEAKING OF APRIL IT'S HERE!

April showers bring May flowers, but I'm hoping April showers bring us some quality May turf conditions heading into the season, and saves us a bit on water along the way. Challenge greens are being punched starting on April 4th and will be ready for play on April 9th. Tees should be done by that Saturday as well, however Fairways take a little longer and will be wrapping up by mid-month. April is definitely the transition month on the turf coming completely out of it's winter dormancy. It's also the month for seeding, weed fighting, calcium and fertilizer applications, and the start-up of a full mow schedule and cup rotations. Busy month - no more blizzards please.

Our capital improvements this year are of the variety that you might not notice much, like new sprinkler heads, although you should see less dry and wet areas with a more uniform watering, and an additional pump to regain our pumping capacity to the originally designed system. I am hoping you'll see a major difference in the quality of cut on our greens with some new state-of-theart triplex greens mowers.



Our agronomy plan for the year really isn't all that different from last season, just more of doing what worked and more frequent applications of what worked, like wetting agent applications to trouble spots, more synthetic acid (totally safe) for water and soil treatments, and more organic fertilizers utilized. We'll have the moss conquered this year and will start a semi-aggressive assault on the poa in our greens. The technology is there for complete eradication, it just takes time, like a couple seasons to accomplish.

Staffing will be up slightly from last season to better maintain bunkers and get more detail work done.






